

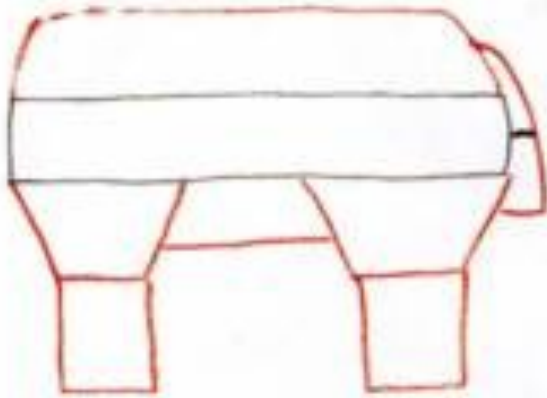

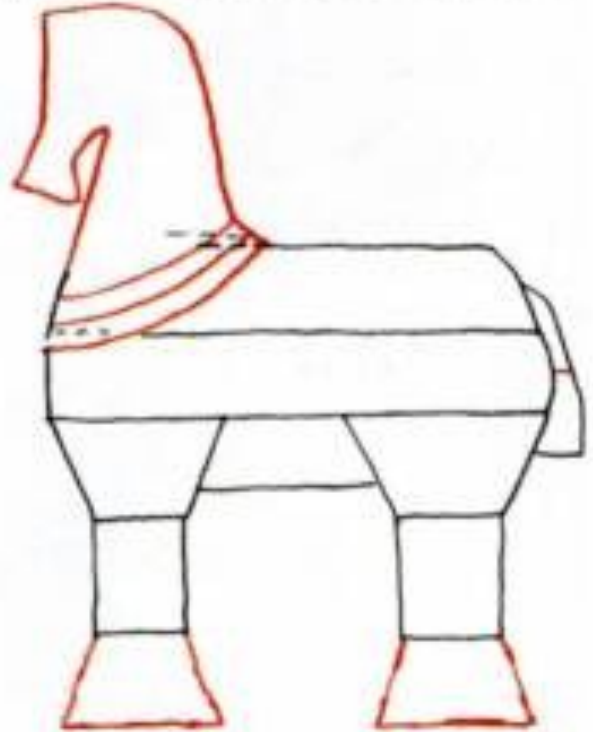
The story of the Trojan Horse is a legend. That means that parts of it might be true, but the truth has been added to or exaggerated. We do know that the Trojan War lasted for ten years between the Mycenaeans and Troy (in present-day Turkey).

Trojan Horse:

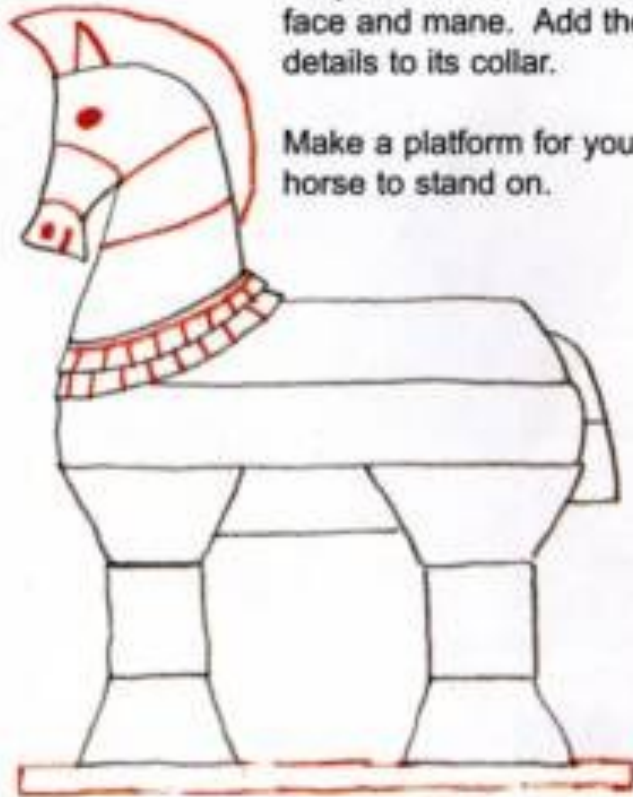
Step 1: Draw a long rectangle. Add the shapes for the horse's body, legs, and tail.



Step 2: Add the horse's head and feet.

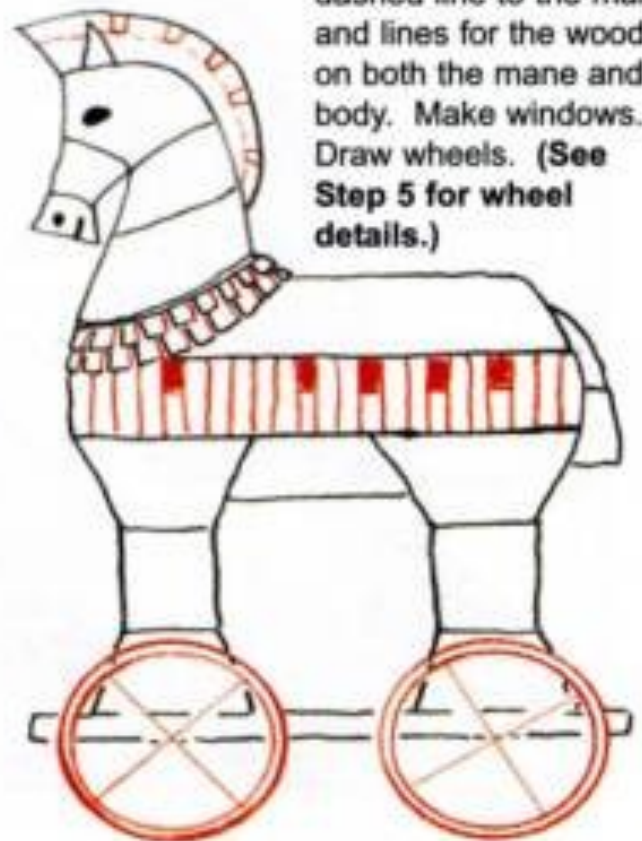


Step 3: Draw the horse's face and mane. Add the details to its collar.



Make a platform for your horse to stand on.

Step 4: Add a light dashed line to the mane and lines for the wood on both the mane and body. Make windows. Draw wheels. (See Step 5 for wheel details.)



Step 5: Wheel Details

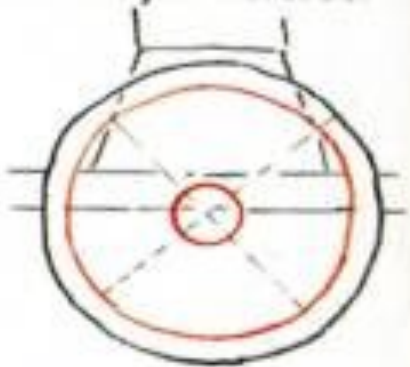
Step 5a: Draw a circle. You may want to trace around something round.



Step 5b: Draw a "X" in the middle of your circle.



Step 5c: Draw two more smaller circles inside your first circle.



Step 5d: Draw one more small circle inside your middle circle. Then add the lines for the spokes. Erase unneeded lines.



Step 6: Draw remaining lines for the boards.

Begin Shading in your horse.



Step 7: Have fun coloring in different shades of golds and browns. Add fine lines for the wood grain as a last step.
